INTRO TO SOCK KNITTING

SUPPLY LIST • FALL 2023

Socks, socks, socks. Ohh, how I love to knit socks. Socks are my favorite knitting project to grab on the go because they are compact and easy to pick up and put down. Not only are knitted socks super comfy and warm goodness on your feet when it's a little chilly out, but they are also works of art on your feet.

In this class, you will learn the basics of knitting socks cuff-down; I will teach a traditional heel-flap and gusset heel construction with a bonus for those who would like to know my favorite short-row heel. In addition, you will learn to knit on tiny double-point needles (DPNs) and knit in the round. I will also introduce contrasting heels, cuffs, and toes for those who like to add more color to their socks. Finally, students will have the opportunity to try a couple of other sock knitting tools.

For this class, I have selected what I have found are good quality, affordable and user-friendly products. So, rather than send you to many different stores to get supplies, I have stocked In Between Stitches with the supplies you would need.

You might already own some of the materials listed below, so please feel free to pick up what you are missing at In Between Stitches. Also, don't hesitate to contact me using the e-mail below if you have questions about the supplies or the class.

MATERIALS NEEDED

- One 100g skein of Fingering weight sock yarn like: Madelinetosh Twist Light Schoppel- Zauberball Crazy Lungauer Sockenvolle Siede Berroco Comfort Sock (wool alternative yarn)
- 1 set ChiaoGoo Stainless Steel DPN's (Double Pointed Needles) in size US 1 or 1.5
- Tapestry needle for weaving in ends
- A couple stitch markers
- Snips or small scissors to cut yarn
- DPN project holder

Supplies to have on hand:

- Susan Bates Fix-it tool or crochet hook
- Pencil or Pen for taking notes, I will be providing handouts.
